Visit Durango is the official destination management and marketing organization of Durango and La Plata County. GENERAL PURPOSE:

The Sustainability & Policy Manager will be a key leader in our local community and at Visit Durango. The Sustainability & Policy Manager will be responsible for creating and implementing new sustainable tourism & destination management programs for La Plata County. This role will help guide the future direction of our organization and the local tourism industry. The main focus of this position will be sustainable tourism, which incorporates the environment, economics, and culture of the destination.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

Sustainability:

- Manage sustainability & destination management certification processes & memberships
- Work in tandem with the Marketing & Sales Departments to create sustainability-focused B2C and B2B campaigns and programs
- Create programs and consult with stakeholders and business partners on energy use, resource conservation, waste management, safety regulations, etc.
- Identify key performance indicators of sustainability for the destination and track progress on an ongoing basis

DEI:

- Collaborates with leadership to implement and monitor Visit Durango's diversity, equity, and inclusion programs both from an organizational standpoint and for marketing and visitor services programs
- Pursue special inclusivity certifications (examples: Autism-Certified, CBTU, etc.)

Policy & Advocacy Programs:

- Advise the Visit Durango staff & Board of Directors on requests for advocacy
- Develop relationships with local and state government officials and political representatives in order to advance the mission of Visit Durango and advocate for the tourism industry. Regularly attend advocacy events
- Stay current on state and federal policy issues that impact travel and tourism
- Apply for, manage, and report on relevant grants
- Produce and give community presentations to stakeholder groups about destination management, sustainability & other topics

- Bachelor's Degree in Environmental Studies, Political Science, or related field
- Expertise and degree, certification, or significant coursework in Sustainable Tourism

- Excellent communication skills (written, verbal, and presentation)
- Leadership skills-- visionary, collaborative, positive, honest, authentic, and ambitious
- Excellent communication and relationship building skills with an ability to prioritize, negotiate, and work with a variety of internal and external stakeholders
- Ability to respond promptly and reasonably when making decisions, effective at problem solving
- Ability to work independently and to carry out assignments to completion within parameters of instructions given prescribed routines, and standard accepted practices
- Commitment to advancing diversity, inclusion, and equity within Visit Durango and the tourism industry
